TeamMates Scholarships Overview

TeamMates Scholarship Application

- Application opens: October 1, 2024
- Application deadline: January 20, 2025
 - Note: To be eligible for college partner scholarships, each college specifies the date the mentee needs to apply for admissions. This is indicated under each college in the description field.
- Mentees must indicate all colleges they are interested in on the application to be considered for their scholarships.
- Students can save their work on the application and come back to finish it before the deadline.
- When mentees complete the one application, they will automatically be considered for all TeamMates scholarships for which they are eligible.

Eligibility Requirements for Mentees

- Must be a high school senior mentee
- · Participated in TeamMates for a minimum of 3 years
- Be a current mentee regularly meeting with their mentor (exceptions may be approved by the TeamMates National Office)
- Must utilize the scholarship beginning in the fall of 2025
- Mentees may apply one time up until the age of 25
- Specific scholarships may have additional eligibility criteria (refer to scholarship descriptions)

Selection Process

- Scholarship applicants will be evaluated based on the following areas:
 - o Academics: 10 points
 - o Essay Questions: 80 points
 - o Letter of Recommendation: 10 points
- TeamMates will notify mentees that have been selected for a competitive scholarship via email in February/March/April 2025. The email will provide specific instructions for mentees to officially accept or decline the scholarship. Mentors and Program Coordinators will also be notified via email.
- College Partners will directly notify mentees that have been selected for a non-competitive scholarship.

Full Tuition (Four-Year Schools)

Scholarship: Midland University (Fremont, NE) Scholarship for TeamMates

Award amount: Full tuition per academic year

Number of scholarships awarded: 1

Criteria:

- Participation in our TeamMates program for a minimum of 3 years.
- Participate in our TeamMates+ post-secondary program following high school graduation.
- Must hold a minimum cumulative high school GPA of 2.5 until graduation.
- > Must complete and apply for admission to Midland University in Fremont, NE no later than January 20th.
- Must complete and submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to Midland University (FAFSA ID 002553) no later than January 20th.
- Must be Pell-eligible as determined by a completed FAFSA submitted to Midland University.
- Must attend Midland University in the Fall 2025 semester.
- Must maintain good academic and disciplinary standing as outlined in the Student Code of Conduct.

<u>Description:</u> This scholarship is competitive and will be paid directly by Midland University at the beginning of each semester. This award cannot be combined with any additional Midland University scholarships. The recipient is responsible for paying fees, room & board, books, and meal plan. Applicants awarded the full tuition scholarship may not be eligible for additional scholarship opportunities through Midland University.

Scholarship: Osborne Legacy Scholarship for TeamMates (Hastings College)

Award amount: Full-tuition per academic year

Number of scholarships awarded: 1

Criteria:

- Participation in our TeamMates program for a minimum of 3 years.
- Participate in our TeamMates+ post-secondary program following high school graduation.
- Must hold a minimum cumulative high school GPA of 2.5.
- Must complete and submit an application for admission to Hastings College in Hastings, NE no later than January 20th.
- Must attend Hastings College beginning in the fall of 2025.
- Must complete and submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to Hastings College no later than February 1st.
- Must be Pell-eligible as determined by a completed FAFSA submitted to Hastings College.
- Must maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 until graduation.

<u>Description:</u> This scholarship is competitive and will be paid directly by Hastings College at the beginning of each semester. This award cannot be combined with any additional Hastings College scholarships. Recipient must also maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 until graduation. Recipient is responsible for paying other fees, room & board, books, and meal plan.

Scholarship: Nebraska Wesleyan University (Lincoln, NE) TeamMates Access Scholarship

Award amount: Full tuition per academic year Number of scholarships awarded: TBD

Criteria:

- Participation in TeamMates program for a minimum of 3 years.
- Participation in our TeamMates+ post-secondary program following high-school graduation.
- Must be accepted for admission to Nebraska Wesleyan University
- Must be a first-year, full-time student (12-18 credit hours per semester) beginning fall 2025.
- Must be federal Pell-grant eligible as determined by a completed Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) submitted to Nebraska Wesleyan University (no later than August 1, 2025). Renewal in future years is dependent on maintaining Federal Pell Grant eligibility.
- Must maintain satisfactory academic progress and agree to comply with all code of conduct standards set by Nebraska Wesleyan University.

<u>Description:</u> This non-competitive scholarship will be paid directly by Nebraska Wesleyan University at the beginning of each semester for a total of four years. The amount of this award is based on the cost of tuition less other gift aid received. The recipient is responsible for paying other fees, housing and food, books, and other personal expenses.

Scholarship: Augustana University (Sioux Falls, SD) TeamMates Promise Scholarship

Award amount: Full tuition per academic year Number of scholarships awarded: TBD

Criteria:

- > Participation in TeamMates program for a minimum of 3 years.
- > Participation in our TeamMates+ post-secondary program following high-school graduation.
- > Must be accepted for admission to Augustana University.
- Must be a first-year, full-time student (12-18 credit hours per semester) beginning fall 2025.
- Must be federal Pell-grant eligible as determined by a completed Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) submitted to Augustana University (no later than June 1, 2025).
 - o Renewal in future years is dependent on maintaining Federal Pell Grant eligibility
- Must maintain satisfactory academic progress and agree to comply with all code of conduct standards set by Augustana University.
- > Must be an undergraduate student.
- Must live in Augustana University housing and sign up for a full Augustana University meal plan.

<u>Description:</u> This non-competitive scholarship will be paid directly by Augustana University at the beginning of each semester for a total of four years (8 consecutive semesters). The amount of this award is based on the cost of tuition less other gift aid received (inclusive of institution, state and federal grants). The recipient is responsible for paying fees, books, room and meal plan.

Partial Tuition (Four-Year Schools)

Scholarship: Creighton University (Omaha, NE) TeamMates Markoe Scholarship

Award amount: \$32,000 toward tuition per academic year

Number of scholarships awarded: 1

Criteria:

- Participation in our TeamMates program for a minimum of 3 years.
- Must participate in our TeamMates+ post-secondary program following high school graduation.
- Must hold a minimum cumulative high school GPA of 3.3.
- Must complete and apply for admission to Creighton University in Omaha, NE no later than December 1st.
- Must attend Creighton University beginning in the fall of 2025.
- Must complete and submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to Creighton University no later than Jan. 15th.
- Must be Pell-eligible as determined by a completed FAFSA submitted to Creighton University.
- Must be a full-time student taking at least 12 credit hours per semester.
- Must maintain good standing as outlined in the student handbook until graduation and agree to comply with all code of conduct standards set by Creighton University.

<u>Description:</u> This renewable scholarship is competitive, and half of the amount awarded will be paid directly by Creighton University at the beginning of each semester for up to four years. This scholarship award is provided by Creighton University and cannot be combined with any additional Creighton University scholarship awards. Recipient must maintain good standing as outlined in the student handbook until graduation and agree to comply with all code of conduct standards set by Creighton University. The recipient is responsible for paying other fees, including food, housing, and books.

Scholarship: TeamMates DREAM Scholarship (Bellevue University in Bellevue, NE)

<u>Award amount:</u> 90% of tuition and fees per academic, (maximum of \$9,600/year or up to a maximum of \$48,000 over 5 years

Number of scholarships awarded: Maximum of 4 Criteria:

- > Participation in our TeamMates program for a minimum of 3 years.
- Must participate in our TeamMates+ post-secondary program following high school graduation.
- Applicant must currently hold a minimum cumulative high school GPA (weighted or unweighted) of 2.5 (on a 4.0 scale) or higher
- Applicant must reside in the State of Nebraska or Iowa.
- Applicant must be U.S. citizens, Legal Permanent Residents or approved DACA
- Starting in fall 2025, applicant must plan to attend Bellevue University in Bellevue, Nebraska as a full-time student, enrolling in 8 credit hours or more per term (Fall, Winter, Spring) in an in-class, traditional format

Application Process:

- > Complete and submit the application for admission to Bellevue University: https://www.bellevue.edu/
- In addition to the TeamMates National Office Scholarship application, the student must also complete the Bellevue University scholarship application and submit a current transcript
 - Submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) (for approved DACA students, please email scholarships@bellevue.edu to find out what materials you will need to complete)
 - An online recommendation form will need to be requested by the student to someone to complete on his/her behalf (this is part of the application process itself)

Selection & Award Information:

- Up to 4 scholarships will be awarded annually.
- Award amounts vary based on need and merit, up to \$9,200 per academic year, for up to a total of 5 years or when a bachelor's degree is earned, whichever comes first. Maximum total award over a 5-year period for an inclass residential student is \$46,000.
- Funds will be applied directly to tuition and fees first, and other educational expenses second, including books, supplies, campus meals, campus housing, and transportation.

- > Participation in our TeamMates program for a minimum of 3 years.
- > Participation in our TeamMates+ post-secondary program following high school graduation is encouraged.
- Must be accepted for admission to Augustana University.
- Must be a first-year, full-time student (12-18 credit hours per semester) beginning fall 2025
- Must maintain satisfactory academic progress and agree to comply with all code of conduct standards set by Augustana University.
- Must be an undergraduate student.

<u>Description:</u> Award amounts vary based on need and merit, to cover at least 75% of full-time tuition per academic year, for up to a total of 4 consecutive years or when a bachelor's degree is earned, whichever comes first. Funds will be applied directly to the students' account at Augustana University and will not exceed their direct costs. Recipient is responsible for paying remaining tuition, fees, books, room and meal plan.
